First Time Admission

All students must submit the required documentation listed below in order to be considered for admission. Applications and forms are accessible from <u>www.calhoun.edu/admissions</u>. In order for transcripts to be considered official, they must be submitted to the Office of Admissions and Records directly from the issuing institution/agency, or if submitted by the student in a sealed envelope from the issuing party.

Required Admission Documentation:

- Calhoun Community College application for admission
- Official high school transcript with posted graduation date or GED certificate with passing scores
- Official college transcripts (if applicable)
 - Students who have achieved a minimum of a Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university are only required to submit an official transcript from the degree granting institution unless seeking a degree from Calhoun Community College.
